



Gong for Cove One

AS water starts to flow in to South Yunderup's new \$16 million artificial lake, the Austin Cove development has been awarded an Urban Development Institute of Australia (UDIA) award.

Satterley chief executive Nigel Satterley described the lake, the biggest in a WA residential land development, as the centrepiece of Austin Cove.

"This lake will cover about 16ha of the total stage and the first stage is the size of Subiaco Oval," he said.

"The total length of the lake will be one and a quarter kilometres."

He said landscaping would soon begin on boardwalks, beaches, picnic areas, playgrounds and pavilions around the lake's edge.

The UDIA award was given to Austin Cove's Stage One for residential development under 250 lots, with judges praising the area's subtle integration of wetlands and parkland.
