



Taste and subtlety win honour

Satterley Property Group's Austin Cove estate has been recognised with an Urban Development Institute of Australia award, coinciding with the completion of an important phase of the project.

Stage 1 of a \$16 million artificial lake has started, creating a body of water that covers an area the size of Patersons Stadium.

Once completed, the lake will cover 16ha and be the centrepiece for the estate.

"The total length of the lake will be one-and-a-quarter kilometres, and it

will help to make Austin Cove one of the most distinctive residential estates south of Perth," Satterley chief executive Nigel Satterley said.

The UDIA acknowledged the project's phase one of a development under 250 lots, at the WA institute's annual ceremony.

It is on the Peel Inlet, and the judges highlighted the estate's integration into the established precinct of South Yunderup.

They praised its tasteful continuity of design and subtle use of parks and wetlands.
